Bruno Janssen was born in Oldenburg, Germany, September 15th, 1850.

He was united in holy matrimony with Margaret Bishop, February 4th, 1874. This union God blessed with eight children of whom three preceded their father in death.

The children are: Gesina,, wife of Herman Luebke, Johanna, deceased, wife of Henry Bruns, Anna, wife of Frank Dankert,, Dietrich and Gerhart, Martha, wife of Mr. Bressler, of Minnesota, and Henrietta and Carl, deceased.

In 1889 he migrated to America and settled in South Dakota, where they lived until 1891, when they moved to Nebraska, locating on a farm northeast of Palmer, where he resided until his death.

He leaves to mourn his departure, his aged widow, five children, 21 grandchildren 4 great grandchildren, and a wide circle of friends.. Mr. Janssen had reached the age of 74 years, 8 months and 18 days.

The funeral was held Friday, June 5th at the Lutheran church, Rev. B. Holm officiating, and interment was made at Rose Hill Cemetery.
