Robert Carl Scheer, of Cordova, died Tuesday, March 22, 2005, at the Fairview Manor in Fairmont at the age of 81 years 6 months and 14 days. He was born September 8, 1923, to Julius Paul and Hattie (Kaiser) Scheer at Chapman, Nebraska the 3rd of five children. Robert was baptized on October 14, 1923 and confirmed on May 23, 1937, both at Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church, Worms, Nebraska.

He attended country school District #28 in Merrick County, Nebraska, and farmed with his father until 1944. Robert was united in marriage to Norma Jean Renken on October 22, 1944. They resided in Grand Island briefly before moving to Tacoma, Washington in 1946 where he worked as a Millwright at Sperry Mills for 20 years and later worked in maintenance for Buffelen Manufacturing Company. Robert was a member of the Air Force Reserves from 1950 to 1953, earning the rank of Corporal. His unit was called to active duty during the Korean Conflict.



After Norma passed away in 1981, Robert returned to the Cordova area where he worked on the farm for his son-in-law, Don Due, retiring in 1985. On February 14, 1982, he was united in marriage to Mary L. Sternberg in Cordova.

Robert was a member of the St. John's Lutheran Church, Cordova and Lutheran Laymen's League. He was also a life member of the American Legion L. Petersen Post #359, Cordova and the National Rifle Association. In his spare time, he enjoyed reading and when his health permitted, he loved to hunt. Robert took great pride in his yard. Robert enjoyed visiting with friends and acquaintances.
