LEXINGTON -- Robert L. Seim, 58, of rural Lexington died of cancer Friday, Nov. 28, 2003, at Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney.

Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Zion Lutheran Church in Worms. The Rev. Robert Harms will officiate. Burial will be in the Rose Hill Cemetery at Palmer.

Visitation will be from 5 to 7 p.m. Monday at Palmer Funeral Home In Palmer.

Mr. Seim was born Nov. 20, 1945, in Grand Island to Reynold and Olga (Meyers) Seim.
